

Final Exam Planned Subject Areas

The Final Exam will draw from several areas of our class. Notable among those areas are Text Readings, Class Lectures, and Outside Readings, as well as topics covered earlier on Exam One. Note that the Exam will emphasize topics covered since the first exam. (Expect about an 80:20 ratio.)

As with the first Exam, anything that was part of class including the 'hands on' activities may be subject to testing. As with the first Exam, we will attempt to emphasize the major concepts of the material covered rather than the nuances. Expect that this Exam will resemble the First Exam in length as well as form. Specific subject areas that you may want to study include:

From text readings, including:

- Chapter 8, Physical Security
- Chapter 9, Software
- Chapter 10, Business Continuity Planning
- Chapter 11, Law

From the Lectures, including:

- Networking Lecture from Day Six
- Security Architecture and Models
- Wireless Security from Day Five

From the Outside Readings, including:

- Increased Security Through Open Source Software
- Wireless Infidelity

From earlier topics, you can expect to see questions concerning Cryptography, Access Control, and Security Models.

Finally, there may be a few questions from: Chapter 14, Secure Software and Chapter 15, Human Factors.
