Assignments

This week, you will focus on completing both your class portfolio (Web Site) and your class poster.

Your poster should present a relevant problem/issue. In your poster, you should also present a solution or a tool that mitigates your chosen problem. With the instructor's permission, you may use another format. Remember that the purpose of the poster is to demonstrate that you can employ technology (cryptology) to improve an organization's security posture.

In terms of audience, both your poster and your web site should be easy for a business person to read and understand. While the tone may be informal, the essay must employ correct grammar and spelling. Within each project, you should communicate in a reasoned and professional manner.
