For next week's outside reading, download and read a copy of "Why Johnny Can't Encrypt" by Alma Whitten [1]. Write a few paragraphs explaining her main point. Further, elaborate on how her theme's essay is, or isn't, relevant today.

For your online journal, you will need to identify an incident whose solution involves the application of cryptology. Better journals will present an incident that illustrates the problem well. You should also write, at least, one paragraph explaining how appropriate use of cryptography could mitigate that type of incident. Your journal should also include a link to the incident referenced in the problem statement. Better essays will include several references.
